- Bedside lamp (Depends on the number and size of rooms.)
- Clothes rack
- Hangers (8 for each bedroom)
- Iron

- Mirror (Depends on the design.)
- Coverlet (Depends on the number and size of rooms.)
- AC (Obligatory in summer destinations, optional in other regions. Depends on the number and size of rooms.)

## ! Important Notes

White sheets, white duvet covers, white pillows, white pillowcases, white bath towels, white hand towels, white foot towels should be available depending on the bed capacity at home.

Example linen scenario: In a house with 2 double beds;

- 4 sheets
- 4 double duvet covers
- 8 pillows (4 in 1 double bed, 2 in 1 single bed.)
- 8 bath towels (as a total of 4 people can stay in the house)
- 8 hand towels (as a total of 4 people can stay in the house)
- 8 foot towels (as a total of 4 people can stay in the house)
- 16 pillowcases (one original and 1 spare for each pillow)
- 2 double duvets (There is no need for a spare in the duvet.)

Please note that Missafir does the last preparatory cleaning of the houses to be managed by Missafir before the houses are opened for reservation. The cleaning fee is collected from the homeowner in cash or deducted from the first earnings.
